



# CODE OF CONDUCT

This code of conduct should be considered in conjunction with existing Union and University guidance and regulations and will sit under the Expect Respect policy.

## SPECTATORS CODE OF CONDUCT

- Do not attempt to bring onto site any alcohol. All alcohol must be purchased from the Varsity Village or the Stags, and only consumed in the authorised and highlighted areas.
- Do not use abusive language or harass, physically or verbally, players, coaches, match officials or other spectators. This includes against both Team Southampton and University of Portsmouth teams and staff respectively.
- Show respect for your team's opponents.
- Show respect for the decision of the match officials.
- Never condone the use of violence and verbal abuse.
- Positively represent Team Southampton, SUSU, and the University.
- Be aware of how your actions can be interpreted and what they can mean for Team Southampton and the wider University. Behave in a way which will not bring any into disrepute – this includes on the pitch, while spectating and during social activities.
- Do not do anything which is likely to intimidate, offend, insult, humiliate or discriminate against any other person.
- Please ensure that any litter is put into the provided bins or taken home, and not left on site.
- Must treat facilities and equipment with respect and care and report any issues immediately.
